



All grade averages met or surpassed national standards


TCP 2008-2009 1st Grade Terra Nova Scores

All grade averages met or surpassed national standards


TCP 2008-2009 2nd Grade Terra Nova Scores






TCP 2008-2009 3rd Grade Ohio Achievement Test




TCP 2008-2009 4rd Grade Ohio Achievement Test
