

And so it is with you... we are in charge of our Attitudes

















TCP World Academy Kindergarten Terra Nova Scores



TCP World Academy 1st Grade Terra Nova Scores




TCP World Academy 2nd Grade Terra Nova Scores




All primary students were tested one grade higher than the grade they were currently in. All grade averages met or surpassed national standards.


TCP World Academy 3rd Grade Ohio Achievement Test
